SOI is the only process to improve the performance of trainer in the instructional delivery or Skills demonstration.

This is a two-week face to face training course. The training requires full time attendance and active participation of all the participants. The participants are required to practice real instructional supervision in the actual training situation

- Reinforce their concept of effective theory and practical instruction;
- Plan effective skill-based lessons;
- Critique instructional planning and delivery;
- Develop coaching, listening, observing and feedback skills;
- Develop a concept of clinical instructional supervision;
- Apply clinical supervision in actual training situations;
- Speak a common language of training terms.

Who will benefit

An instructional supervisor is effective for trainers, lecturers or instructors first, this course is limited to:

Lead teachers, Senior instructors, Senior trainers, lecturers; Training organization managers, such as supervisors, department heads, principals, vice-principals, training managers, course directors, program coordinators;
