Introduction

ToT-V is the second course in a training path for trainers. This is a two-week face to face training course. The training requires full time attendance and active participation of all the participants.

This course is to provide training institutions with highly skilled, creative trainers capable of planning, delivering and evaluating individual training sessions.

Course goals

At the end of course, participants will be able to:

- ✓ Select appropriate non-projected instructional media.
- ✓ Develop instructional media using locally available resources
- ✓ Design and develop effective visual images using technology approaches
- Apply design concepts when visualizing message.
- ✓ Speak a common language of media terms.

Who will benefit

This course is appropriate for pre- and inservice trainer/instructional staff, field workers, instructional material developers from the public and private sectors.

Areas covered

The following areas are specifically address in the course.

- Development of models, stencils, templates and visualized teaching packages.
- ✓ Preparation of wall charts, flipcharts, animated charts and flip pictorial manuals
- Presentation of information with chalkboards, marker board, pin board, flip charts, wall charts, animated charts, virtual reality and other threedimensional instructional aids.
- ✓ Graphical visualization of statistical/numerical information
- Evaluation of instructional media

The course language will be in English. Instructional materials provided are also in English.
